

Who is Wade Trim?

Wade Trim is an engineering firm built on civil infrastructure design and construction. The company began as a small engineering firm in Detroit almost one hundred years ago. That firm was purchased by two of its employees, Bob Wade and Don Trim, and to this day continues to help communities across the eastern United States find solutions to their water, wastewater, and wet weather needs from their 18 offices in nine states; six of those offices are here in Michigan.

Partnering with townships, cities, and villages on the best ways to handle sanitary sewer collection and treatment, along with providing safe, clean drinking water for communities continues to be a priority for Wade Trim, and their work assisting local units of government has earned them numerous awards.

Wade Trim has been involved in the Two Lake Cooperative Sewer Authority (TLSA) since its inception in 2017, lending their expertise to a project aimed at protecting two of the brightest gems in Manistee County: Portage Lake and Bear Lake.

Their team has prepared the project's engineering report; first published in 2019 and revised in 2021 and continues to work closely with the TLSA to answer questions and explain the need of a project of this scope.
